INDIVIDUAL SUPPLIES

- 🐭 Lunch Bag – The lunch bag should fit snack, water bottle, and lunch.
 - 🐭 Leak-proof Water Bottle
- 🐭 All-In-One Rest Time Mat (The rest mat should roll up and have a handle for ease when going back and forth to school.). Please see the links on the class website.
 - 🐭 Sturdy Two Pocket Folder
- 🐭 Backpack – The backpack should fit the folder and lunch box. Please do not get a mini backpack.

BASIC INFORMATION

Welcome to Sacred Heart Catholic Academy's nursery program. We are so honored that you have chosen to entrust us with your child's safety and education. We promise to do our best to promote your child's spiritual, academic, social, emotional, and physical development throughout the school year.


Below we have listed some basic information, suggestions, and requests that will help to make this a wonderful year for you and your child.


- 🐭 **Nursery Prerequisites:** The two main things that are expected of your child when entering nursery is that he/she can talk and is potty trained. If there is an accident, and it is beyond our ability to assist, we must have a contact to call and come to school to change your child.
- 🐭 **Drop – Off:** 8:10-8:20am – Please do your best to be punctual as we want to create a routine with children and get the day started as a group. We know that coming to school might be new to many of our nursery students. We will be there to help to make the transition as smooth as possible.
- 🐭 **Snack/Lunch:** Snack (all students) and lunch (full day students only) should be packed in an insulated lunch bag. Please be sure to pack something that your child will enjoy eating. They need lots of energy to get through their busy days!
- 🐭 **Bathroom:** Please be sure to take your child to the bathroom before bringing them into school. We will make trips to the bathrooms throughout the day, and of course, at the request of each child at any time. Please be sure that your child can manage the clothing that he or she is wearing (i.e. belts, buttons, zippers, etc.). **Change of clothes:** Please provide a complete change of clothing (shirt, pants, underwear, and socks). They should be placed in a Ziploc bag with your child's name on it. We will return these as necessary.
- 🐭 **Labels:** Please be sure that EVERYTHING sent into school is labeled (lunchboxes, coats, backpacks, etc.).
- 🐭 **Birthday Celebrations:** We will happily schedule to celebrate your child's birthday! We invite you to bring an individual – STORE BOUGHT snack for each student, and if your schedule permits, you can come in to help celebrate and read your child's favorite book to the class. All snacks must be individual and completely peanut free. We will have a summer birthday celebration in June. If you would like to schedule a celebration, please let us know at least a week ahead of time. We like to inform everyone of snacks that will be brought in on a given day.

 **Outside Play/Gym:** When the weather permits, we will be bringing the children outside. Please keep this in mind when dressing your child in the morning. Also, please keep in mind that sneakers are always the safest choice for your child whether we are going outside or playing in the gym.

 **Folders:** It is extremely important that you check your child's folder each day. Important papers and their beautiful artwork will be sent home in their folders.

 **Email/Communication:** While you can always contact us by putting a note in your child's folder, please feel free to email us at vreinhart@sacredheartbayside.org. Please have an email setup that you will regularly check. The easiest way for us to communicate and send newsletters is through email. It is very important that you check it regularly.

 **Pickup Information:** It is important that we have the correct information regarding the people you give permission to pick up your child from school. We must have written consent to dismiss your child to someone other than you. Please send in a note with the name and relationship of anyone new picking up your child. Until we recognize them, we ask that they approach us to introduce themselves. The safety of your child is our biggest concern.

 **Dismissal:** Half day dismissal is at 11:20am. Full day dismissal is at 2:35pm. Please do your best to be punctual. In the morning, we need to get back to the classroom after dismissal, and in the afternoon the UPK is dismissed directly following nursery.

We look forward to a wonderful year and to creating a special learning experience for your child.

A Typical Day in Nursery

- 🐻 **Arrival Activities:** Hang up coat, unpack and put away backpack, hand in folder, and choose a table top activity (puzzles, library, etc.) to work on until we start the day.
- 🐻 **Morning Meeting/Circle Time:** Prayer, calendar, weather, 10-day board, daily schedule, introduce letter and number of the week, and various other activities.
- 🐻 **Center Time:** The children will rotate between centers that will change each day (i.e. kitchen and dramatic play, fine motor skills, building, Legos, doctor, crafts, etc.).
- 🐻 **Snack**
- 🐻 **Storytime – Lesson (theme) – Music**
- 🐻 **Morning Dismissal**
- 🐻 **Recess**
- 🐻 **Lunch**
- 🐻 **Rest Time**
- 🐻 **Free Play, Additional Center Time, and Circle Time Activities**
 - 🐻 **Specials:** In addition to our regular time in the classroom, the children will also have physical education class in the gym (Ms. Flynn), art in the classroom (Mrs. Waranis), and music in the classroom (Mrs. Jessica).
